- 3.3 The competitors have to prepare the copy of their ID card, and give to the facilitator at the registration zone.

1) Studying in Grade 4-6	in 6 - 7 minutes
2) Studying in Grade 7-9	in 6 - 7 minutes
3) Studying in Grade 10-12 or Vocational Certificate 1-3	in 7 - 8 minutes
4) Studying in Undergraduate	in 7- 8 minutes

For introducing yourself will not be counted in the time (under 30 seconds will not cut down the score) less or more than the given time, the judges will cut down 1 score/1 minute.
- 3.5 Every competitor has to wear their students uniform without any equipment, songs, the copy version of the story and others.
- 3.6 The competition's order will be random at the registration zone or the competition's room.
